Houseplant Care

Water your plant the same day you pot it (if a snake, ZZ, hoyo, cactus, or other dry-loving plant, wait 1-2 weeks to water, or whenever new soil fully dries)

Thoroughly saturate the soil.

If your pot has drainage let water flow through for a few seconds.

If your pot does not have drainage give 1-3 cups of water depending on the size of your pot

After the first or second watering you can choose to bottom water your plant. Submerge the pot in a bowl of water until soil saturates to the top and then return to drip tray.

Watering schedule depends on your plant! Ask a team member for the best time to water your specific plant

A good rule of thumb is every 6-10 days for houseplants and every 10-14 days for plants like snakes, ZZ'ss and cactus. Feel your soil to better understand the rate it is drying out.

Most plants will give you visible signs of needing water such as thin paper-like, or drooping leaves.
